Transportation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Take KTX at Gwangmyeong Station (광명역): 경기 광명시 광명역로 21 (우)14347 / www.letskorail.com / Phone # 1544-7788 - Go to Busan Station (부산역). It will take about 2 hr, and price is about 57700 원. - At Busan Station take a subway, Line 1, Nopo Direction (노포방면). It will take 37 min, 20 stops. - Get off at Beomeosa Station (범어사역). - Take a bus #90, and get off at the Beomeosa ticket office. It will take 9 min, 4 bus stops.

Summary	Beomousa is a very beautiful temple. It was built at 678, Shilla era. The name of the temple, Beomousa means the fish which came from heaven. According to the legend, there was a golden pond in that mountain, and a golden fish came from heaven and played in the pond.

Transportation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Take a bus #90, and get off Beomousa Station. - Take line 1, Dadaepo beach direction, and get off at Dongnae Station (동래역) - Come out through exit #2 and walk 15 min.

Summary	This restaurant descended from the forth generation. Very famous restaurant. Their Korean pancake is thick and soft.

Transportation	From 동래읍성지, it will take 13 min by a taxi. If you want to take a bus, you have to walk to the bus stop for about 15 min. The bus stop name is Nongshimga Super bus stop (농심가슈퍼 정류장). Take a bus named Dongnaegu 7. Get off at 온천극장 (Hot Spring Theater) bus stop. It will take 9 min, 8 bus stops.

Hour	5:30am to midnight (FYI. The women's section is remodeling right now. It will be reopened on June 1 st .)
Summary	This is a public bath place with hot spring waters. It is good for your skin and health. Also there are sauna rooms on 3 rd floor. A restaurant and a cafeteria are in the building. At the entrance, you receive a key for your locker. With that key, you can use convenient facilities and buy food. Then pay when you leave.

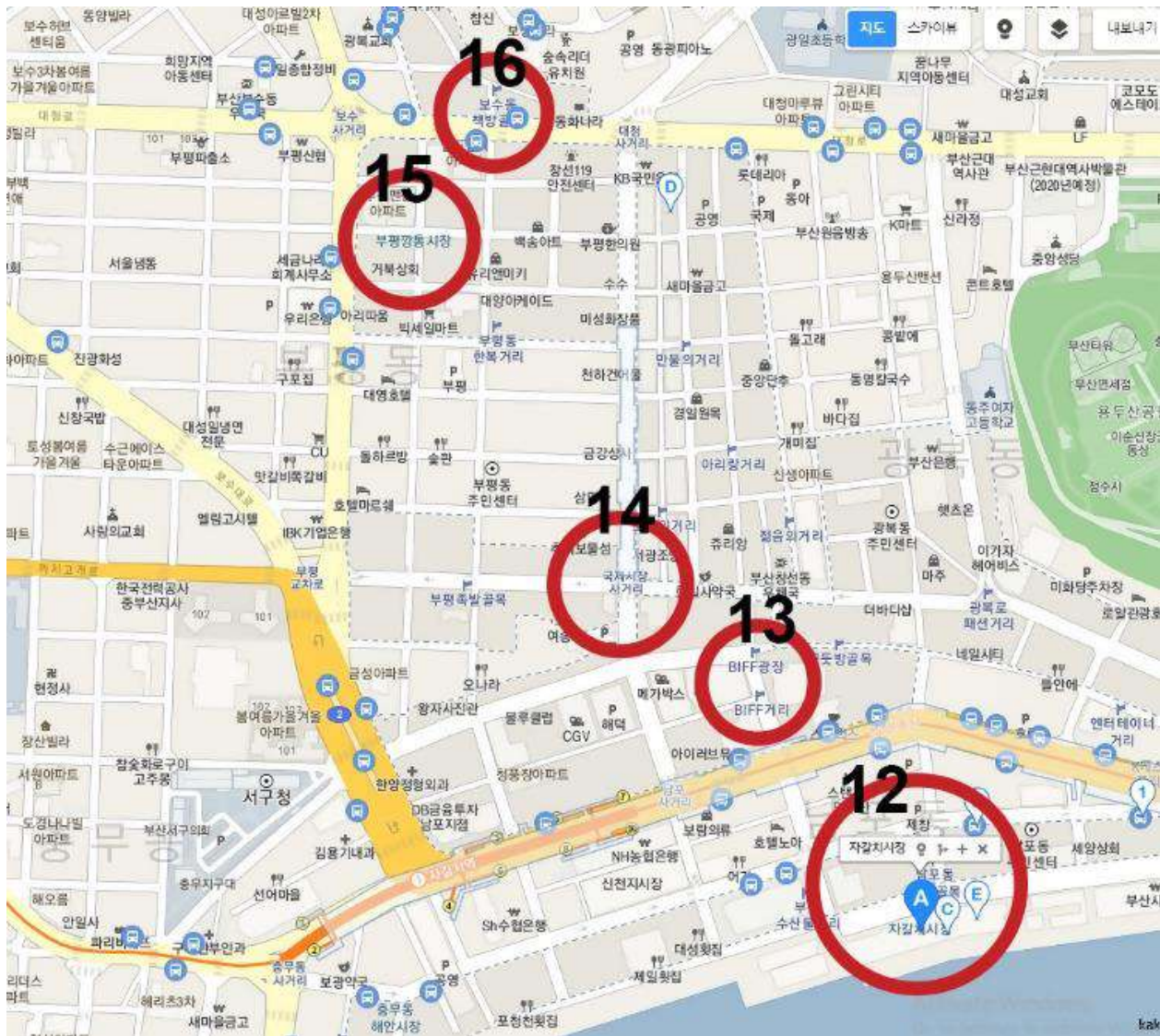

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Take a bus #1011, after 48 min, 8 bus stops, then get off at Busan Natural Gas Power Plant bus stop (부산천연가스발전소 정류장). - Walk to Gamcheon Crossroads bus stop (감천 사거리 정류장). - Take a bus named Sahagu 1, Sahagu 2-2 or Sahagu 1-1, and get off at Gugam bus stop (구감 정류장). It will take 6 min, 6 bus stops.

Transportation	Take a bus at Gamcheon Elementary School (same as Gamcheon Culture Village bus stop), a bus named Seogu 2 (서구 2). After 10 min, 13 bus stops passed, get off at Chungmoodong Crossroads (충무동 교차로). Then you can transfer to a bus #17, 87 or 9 and get off Jagalchi Entrance bus stop (자갈치 입구 정류장). Otherwise, I think you can walk from Chunmoodong Crossroads. It is four blocks way, just one bus stop long.

	If you take a taxi from the village to this market, it will take 14 min, and cost will be about 5100 원.

Summary	<p>This is the biggest seafood market in Korea. Some stores have dining places also. Therefore, you can pick some seafood you want to eat and they cook or just cut as sashimi for you. However, there will be extra charge for eating there. People said it is worth. Food is very fresh, and there are some extra side dishes for free. Also, there are more things to see near the market.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Biff Square (Ref. #13, Biff 광장): In here, Busan International Film Festival held. - The International Market (Ref. #14, 국제시장): There was a movie named 국제시장. You can see the actual market which was in the movie. - Bupyeong Can Market (Ref. #15, 부평깡통시장): Right after Korean War, people sold and bought some relief supplies they had which were in cans. Therefore, the market name is Can Market. Now, it is just a regular market. They sell delicious food and others. - Bosudong Book Street (Ref. #16, 보수동 책방 골목) : You can buy old, used or new books here. There are many book stores in this street.
